

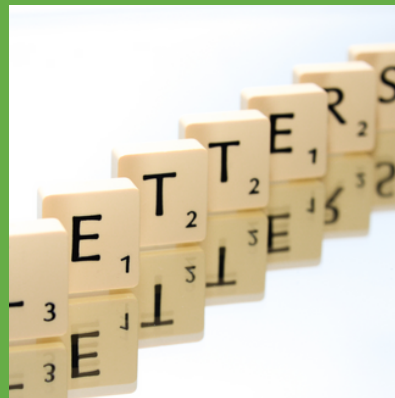

Accessibility 101

How to make your presentations accessible for all audiences

POSTER PRESENTATIONS



Font:

Use non-serif (san-serif) fonts.

Example:

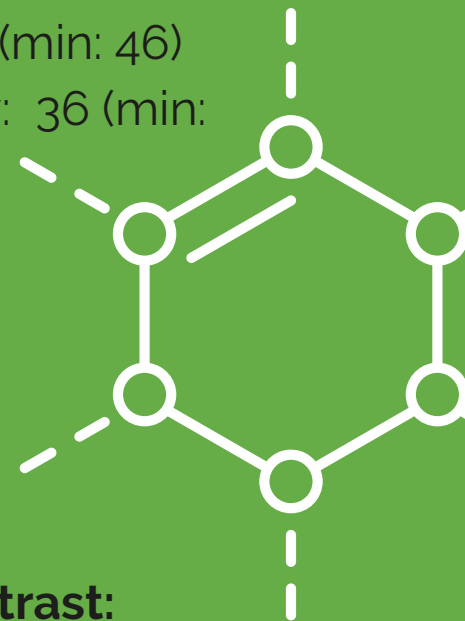
- Helvetica
- Veranda
- Times New Roman



Text Size:

Poster text should be legible 3-6 feet away. Recommended Font Sizes:

- Title: 158 (min: 72)
- Section Title: 56 (min: 46)
- Block Text/Body: 36 (min: 24)



Color Contrast:

Use high contrast color combinations to make your text/visuals more visible.



QR Code:

If you have a lot of information to share, and not enough space on your poster, having a QR code that leads to a document with more information can be helpful.
